**On-Time Payments:** Payments must be received (not postmarked) prior to the specified date to avoid either a late payment charge or possible disconnection of electrical service for nonpayment. Failure to receive the bill does not exempt you from monthly payment, late charges, or disconnection.

**Past Due:** If your bill states, "PAST DUE AMOUNT / SERVICE SUBJECT TO DISCONNECT IF PAST DUE BALANCE IS NOT PAID IMMEDIATELY," that balance needs to be paid immediately to avoid disconnection.

**Paid In Full:** Accounts are considered paid when the full amount due is received. If you mail your payment, please allow time for delivery.

**Residential Budget Payment Plan:** Residential members with twelve (12) months of billing history may be eligible for a Variable or Fixed Budget Payment Plan.

**Other Ways to Pay Your Bill**

- Online:** Provides access to your energy account, payment and usage history through SmartHub. Visit [www.rollinghills.coop](http://www.rollinghills.coop) to register.
- Phone:** Use secure automated phone system to pay your bill by calling (844) 965-1345.
- SmartHub App:** Download the free app to your smart phone to pay your bill and more. Search for SmartHub in your app store.

- ▶ **A. OUR CONTACT INFO:** How to reach us or find information.
- ▶ **B. YOUR ACCOUNT INFORMATION:** Member name, account number or invoice number and bill date for the current bill.
- ▶ **C. BILLING SUMMARY:** Find your past payments, current charges and total charges due.
- ▶ **D. TOTAL DUE:** The total you owe and the due date. If you are enrolled in Auto-Pay, you will see: **PAID BY BANK DRAFT** or **PAID BY CREDIT CARD — DO NOT PAY.**
- ▶ **E. YOUR CONTACT INFO:** The primary phone number and email we have for you. Please keep these updated! This is how we reach you in emergencies or to ask questions.
- ▶ **F. MESSAGE CENTER:** This space will contain important messages about your account and updates on other items of interest to our members.
- ▶ **G. PAYMENT STUB:** If mailing your payment, please return this stub to ensure the payment is properly credited to your account(s).
- ▶ **H. CURRENT BILLING DETAILS:** The table at the top of the section shows the meter number, rate schedule, service dates, meter readings, and other information. This is followed by a summary of the energy and service charges.
- ▶ **I. ENERGY USE COMPARISON:** The graph shows your total monthly energy (kWh) and demand (kW) for the past 13 months. The bubbles below the graph show information for this month, last month, this month last year and average daily.
- ▶ **J. TOTAL CURRENT CHARGES:** A total of current charges for each service.
- ▶ **K. INFORMATIONAL:** Here you will find information about outages, on-time payments, and ways to pay your bill.

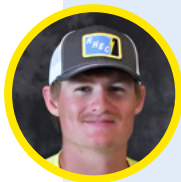
